A. Communication: build understanding through effective internal and external communication systems.

1. Complete revisions to the District's method of reporting student progress to parents of elementary school students.
2. Assist the School Board in updating the School District's long range strategic improvement plan.

B. Resources: Utilize District resources efficiently through effective management and training.

1. Utilize American Recovery and Reinvestment Act funds in a manner that will increase the District's capacity to improve student achievement in a sustainable manner.
2. Assist the School Board with ensuring a smooth transition of Mason students into the Milford School District.
3. Research and report the advantages and disadvantages of the District's utilization of purchasing insurance through a commercial vendor.
4. Assist the School Board in negotiations with the Milford Administrative Group for a successor agreement that attracts and retains quality administrators at a rate that is acceptable to Milford Taxpayers.
5. Investigate an early drop-off/breakfast program for students at the Jacques and Heron Pond schools.

C. Curriculum: Develop and implement an integrated curriculum and effective instructional strategies.

1. Ensure a smooth transition for the integration of kindergarten into the District's educational continuum.
2. Continue to expand personalization efforts through the implementation of Response to Intervention instructional practices through grade five.
3. Develop a method of reporting student progress that is determined by multiple assessments for each student and that demonstrates aggregate achievement for whole student cohort groups.

It is the intent of the District to continue with initiatives that have now become practice. These include publication of a District Report Card, systemic training in literacy instruction, continued ongoing review of Board policy, and development of electronic portfolios. Personalization of education will continue to drive our work.
