## **Carpet Replacement At The High School**

Student Services: The carpet in this area is over 20 years old and placed over asbestos tile. The carpet is in need of replacement due to wear and the formation of ripples in the carpet which causes a tripping hazard. The plan is to remove the existing carpet and abate the asbestos composition tile and replace with new carpet.

Marketing and Business Classrooms: Rooms 104, 215, 217, 219, 219A, and 316 will have the existing carpet removed and vinyl composition tile (VCT) installed. The carpet is over 15 years old, is worn, and is rippled, which causes a tripping hazard.

Anticipated Cost: \$39,000

## **Wireless Access Infrastructure District – Wide**

There is a significant shift occurring in the type of personal computer equipment that is being sold and used by consumers. In 2013, 60% of all personal computers were traditional desktops and laptops. The remaining 40% were tablet devices. By 2017 it is estimated that tablets and other wireless devices will outsell desktop computers by 4 to 1. Currently the School District has extremely limited wireless capabilities. This lack of capacity should be addressed to support the increasing growth in wireless computing. The plan is to deploy a system that will provide access for wireless devices in all school buildings throughout the District. This will require the installation of approximately 150 access points, 10 switches and a wireless network controller. Implementation of wireless will allow students and staff the ability to effectively utilize contemporary technologies to support 21<sup>st</sup> Century teaching and learning.

Anticipated Cost: \$172,000
