**MILFORD SCHOOL BOARD Minutes
(SCHOOL ADMINISTRATIVE UNIT No. 40)
Public Hearing to Receive and Expend Unanticipated Revenue
December 20, 2010**

- 1. Call to Order** Chairman Bragdon called this Milford School District Public Hearing Relative to RSA 198:20b (Hearing to Receive and Expend Unanticipated Revenue) to order at 7:07 p.m. on Monday, December 20, 2010, in Lecture Hall #182 at the Milford High School, following recess of the regular School Board meeting. Those present, together with School District officials and interested citizens, were:

- 2. Introductory Comments** Chairman Bragdon noted that, before a school district can receive and expend unanticipated revenue, there had to be a public hearing before making a decision to do so. He then asked if Superintendent Suprenant had any remarks.

Superintendent Suprenant reviewed his announcement at the 12-06-10 School Board meeting, noting that half of the \$41,000,000 in Jobs Funds provided to the State of New Hampshire had been dedicated to school districts for new or existing positions, but the Department of Education had asked that School Boards discuss potential uses of the money and let that agency know if the School Board did not want to use the money. Other than this, he said, there was no need to act on accepting the money at this time, adding that the Board could delay acting until next year or could place the money in next year's budget.
- 3. Comments and Questions** Chairman Bragdon asked for questions from members of the School Board. None were brought forward. Chairman Bragdon noted that the purpose of the hearing was to accept public input relative to this funding. He noted that the budget itself would be discussed later in the meeting. No comment being brought forward from the attending public, he said the Board could close the hearing and take it up at a later time.
- 4. Closing** Chairman Bragdon declared the public hearing closed at 7:18 p.m., noting that return to the School Board's regular meeting would follow.
