



# Accomplishments Across the District

This past year, we successfully accomplished the following:

- \* **Security Cameras** were installed in every building across the district.
- \* We launched the **Twitter Feed: @Sau40Schools** to quickly highlight all the education articles relevant to what we do, along with accomplishments and activities taking place across the district each day in easy to view posts.
- \* The **Portrait of a Graduate** was developed by over 70 individuals from across Milford including students, teachers, parents, residents, board members & business leaders focused on 4 priority areas, **Future-Reading Student Success, Innovative & Purpose Driven Learning Culture, Policy & Communication, and Community Engagement.**
- \* This Spring, we launched a new **Applicant Tracking System** that is expanding our recruiting reach, and streamlining our HR and Hiring processes district wide.
- \* We have **successfully negotiated contracts** with the Teachers Association and the Facilities Staff and even with additional benefits impacting the district budget, both were approved by voters.
- \* We organized the first **Drug-Sweep** of Milford High School in collaboration with Local Law Enforcement Agencies, as a first step in addressing the rise in drug and vaping challenges we are seeing in our schools and community.
- \* We have almost brought to completion all the facilities and maintenance work required for the **\$3 Million bond projects.**
- \* We **revamped our budgeting process** to offer more transparency about where district resources are being focused and why, while also making the process more collaborative between all stakeholders to strategically impact the areas of greatest need identified through key data gathered from across the district.
- \* This was the first year administrators **shadowed students** in our district gaining added insight and useful information on how our students experience their classes and schools.
- \* Our District **STEAM night** was a huge success and continues to grow each and every year
- \* We had incredibly successful **career days, job fairs, and open houses** enlisting hundreds of participants and local partners to help provide our students with real-world exposure to prepare them for college, career, and life success
